Going to a small school has given me the opportunity to develop friendly relationships with my teachers and reach out to my peers when I have a question. I was never afraid to push myself at Sacred Heart. Throughout my time as a student, I surprised myself by joining clubs, sports and other extracurricular activities. I am a part of the Ambassador Society, Letter Women Society, and held the position of Senior Class Vice-President. Never in a million years did I imagine myself being a 4-year Cross Country and Track and Field runner nevertheless a marathon runner, all while pushing through the disadvantage I face with asthma.

Sacred Heart has become a place that has empowered me. There is a stigma that much of the gap in educational achievement between Latinas and others can be traced to poverty and social disadvantage. However, at Sacred Heart we do not let society define us. Sacred Heart High School has provided me with a first class education while maintaining a 100% graduation rate and 100% college attendance rate. All this would not be possible without the support of alumnae and friends' support of the Comet Scholarship Fund which is why I am forever grateful and blessed.

Sister Lupe Solano Endowment Scholarship

Sister Lupe Solano was among the graduates of the Class of 1965. Filled with compassion and love, Sister Lupe dedicated her life to service for others. She devoted herself to ensuring that the young women of the community, many with harsh backgrounds, would receive the education, love and guidance necessary to succeed in life.

Sister Lupe suffered from a severe respiratory illness, one which finally limited her to a pneumatic environment. It was with a deep sense of loss to her family, the Sisters, the communities she served and her fellow graduates when she passed away in April 1996.
